It's a unique opportunity for competitive winners to rub shoulders with a wealth of professional talent and really get to see firsthand how the prosprepare and perform.

ONLINE OUTREACH

Our audience is very active online and we take full advantage of all opportunities to connect with our dancers, faculty, and fans through social media and online streaming of our dance events. For our corporate sponsors this means much more exposure, as messages get shared not only by **On The Floor**, but also by our wide network of followers.

OTF's online reach includes more than **21,900** direct fans and followers of our social media channels. Our faculty members - including dance stars Jordan Clark, Jennie Pappas, Briar Nolet and Mitchell Jackson - share OTF posts to a combined audience of over **1,377,000** (yes, that's **OVER ONE MILLION**) fans in their social media networks













SPONSORSHIP CONDITIONS

Sponsorship funds will contribute to the promotion, planning and operation of the event. Funds will be used to subsidize cost components such as printing, promotion, purchasing of supplies, prizes, etc.

Sponsorship conditions are negotiable and the event organizers are open to discussion of special requirements or sponsor benefits. Sponsors are responsible for producing and providing their own promotional materials. Sponsorship dollars are required to be paid in full within seven business days of signing the sponsorship agreement.

We accept sponsorship all year round; however, due to program printing deadlines, we may carry on your sponsor advertising in the following year if received after our printing deadline.

SPONSORSHIP VS. SUPPORTER

We appreciate all sponsors and supporters of the **Gala**; however, it is important to set out the difference between the two.

A **sponsor** of the event is providing a sponsorship dollar amount to assist with the running of the event (as set out above). Sponsorship dollars help with the printing, promotion, and purchasing of supplies to run the event. As a sponsor, you can receive a **Gift Confirmation Letter** from the SickKids Foundation for your sponsorship, as well as receiving the benefits of sponsorship from **On The Floor** (see chart on page 6). A sponsor would make their cheque payable to **On The Floor**.

A **supporter** of the event is a company or individual who provides an in-kind donation (i.e. decorations/food for the event, promotion draw, or auction prize). A company or individual who provides an in-kind item will receive a **Gift In Kind Letter** or **Gift Confirmation Letter** from **SickKids Foundation** for business expense purposes.

What kind of items are you accepting for the silent auction and raffle table?

Do you still accept items on the day of?

YES. We accept items, donations and sponsorship dollars all year round.

What is the program deadline for the gala?

The program deadline is two weeks before the event. All logos or ads must be received before this deadline date in order to be included in that year's program.

When do I receive my sponsorship tickets?

If you are a Silver Level Sponsor (or up), you will receive two complimentary tickets. You must reserve your tickets when you submit your sponsorship forms and they are only available on a first come first serve basis (while quantities last).

What is the difference between a sponsor and a supporter?

A **sponsor** of the event is providing a sponsorship dollar amount to assist with the running of the event (as set out above). Sponsorship dollars help with the printing, promotion, and purchasing of supplies to run the event. As a sponsor, you can receive a **Gift Confirmation Letter** from the SickKids Foundation for your sponsorship, as well as receiving the benefits of sponsorship from **On The Floor** (see chart on page 6). A sponsor would make their cheque payable to **On The Floor**.

A **supporter** of the event is a company or individual who provides an in-kind donation (i.e. decorations/food for the event, promotion draw, or auction prize). A company or individual who provides an in-kind item will receive a **Gift In Kind Letter** or **Gift Contribution Letter** from **SickKids Foundation** for business expense purposes.







Will I get a tax receipt?

OTF will accept direct contributions/donations to the SickKids Foundation. Cheques in this case should be made payable directly to SickKids Foundation and forwarded to our On The Floor offices. A tax receipt can be provided if the dollar amount is more than \$25.00. If you wish to receive a tax receipt, please indicate that to us and provide your full name and mailing address. Tax receipts are prepared directly by the SickKids Foundation and not OTF.

Donated items are not eligible for a tax receipt, but a gift in kind letter for corporations, confirming that an item was donated for a SickKids event and the total value of the item may be used as documentation for business expense purposes. There is no tax benefit to an individual for in-kind donations.

Do supporters get recognition in the program?

We do our best to recognize all supporters in the program; however, depending on printer deadline, program outlines and our volunteer timeframes we may not get everyone in. If you want your logo included in the program as a supporter, please ensure you have supplied us with your logo at least three weeks prior to the program printing deadline.

What forms of payment do you accept for sponsorship?

Sponsorship dollars will be accepted by cheque or e-transfer to lisa@onthefloor.ca.

What forms of payment do you accept for direct SickKids donations?

We will accept donations by cash and/or cheques made payable to SickKids Foundation.

Who do we make our cheques out to?

Sponsorship cheques are to be made out to On The Floor. Direct donation cheques are to be made out to SickKids Foundation.
